Roles and Responsibilities

Major Activities

- Train and mentor children in the age group of 11 years and 15 years
- Prepare and facilitate value-based education sessions

Key Requirements/Dependencies

- Professional degree (any stream)
- Excellent oral communication skills and language proficiency
- Genuine sensitivity to the needs of individual children
- Attitude and manner reflecting the high standards and ideals expected of a role model
- Demonstrated skill in query handling and public speaking
- Capable of connecting world events to content in a session
- Expert level knowledge in mass communication, mass training

Preferred Requirements/Dependencies

- Demonstrated skills of relating behavioral/philosophical concepts to contemporary concepts
- Exposure to training methods specifically for the adolescent audience

Responsibilities

His/Her responsibility will be:

- To handle value-based education sessions for children
- To develop and facilitate dynamic and engaging lesson materials for children
- To implement a variety of learning/training concepts and principles for the sessions
- To ensure at all times the integrity and correctness of content delivered
- To represent the organization in spiritual or social responsibility forums/mass media and communicate the organization's philosophical knowledge effectively
- To modify content (if required) according to geographical location and language
- To develop effective relationships with parents; understand and discuss the child's individual needs and progress with their parents
- To submit periodic reports to superiors as and when required
- To continually monitor and assess every student's performance in class and through assignments, exercises, projects, etc.
- To participate in professional activities designated by the superiors, which may include workshops, retreats, meetings, planning, etc.
